OPEN FORUM

A committee was formed to look into the possible use of a Bow Hunting Organization to assist with control of our deer population. Wildlife Management of NC is being contacted to help us again evaluate our problem and advise us on a solution. Alex Roland, Ed Carlson and Al Hoppensteadt are working on this problem.

BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

FIREWISE: The contract for 2010-2011 is still in process. Our next event is 9/25 following the chili supper when Curtis Ish will give a FIREWISE presentation.

WEB: Next week will be the first test of a new email system that will help us eliminate the need to use private email addresses to send out our weekly emails and other emails.

Cascade Creek pond is still leaking. After discussion, the board voted to buy Sodium Bentonite to try to stop the leaks by the dam.

The board has a blacktop contractor coming in to look at the following:

Repairing pothole on Plateau Lane

Evaluating the crack on Cascade Creek road

Looking at tennis courts and Boulder Ridge roads for recommendations

Give us an estimated price for re-surfacing one-mile of road to update our road reserve cost.

We are starting a fall landscaping program. Priorities will be liming grass, re-seeding the really bad bare areas on the side of the roads and removing dead trees from the common areas and along side the roads. The removal of these trees will not only improve the appearance of the community but, more importantly, will eliminate possible damage from falling trees during storms.
